Scripture | Observation | Application | Prayer

Our desire is that every believer would learn to hear from God daily through His Word. We believe that being in the word daily shapes the way we think, transforms our heart, and helps us become more like Jesus!

One practical way to study the Bible is to use the SOAP Method:

SCRIPTURE

Read, highlight, and notate the scripture of the day.

OBSERVATION

Write down observations about the scripture you just read.

What do you think God is saying through this scripture?

APPLICATION

Personalize what you have read by asking yourself how it applies to your life right now.

PRAYER

Write down a personal message from you to God based on what you just learned, and ask him to help you apply this truth in your life.
